SOFTWARE SETTING

Before installing the interface , you need to set it up according to your car make in order to choose the dedicated software.

Shift the switches with care using a small screwdriver .

PAIRING PROCEDURE

CTUNIPAR05 is a wireless module which replace the original car kit remote control. During the intallation the remote control should.not be paired with the car kit to allow the RADICOM to pair automatically with it.

In case of the remote control has already been paired to the car kit, please follow the below descripted procedure:

PRESS 5 TIMES **VOLUME** — FOLLOWED BY **VOLUME** +

(-+-+-+-+)

ONCE THIS PROCEDURE HAS BEEN COMPLETED, REMOVE THE KEY FROM THE INSTRUMENT PANNEL AND THEN RESTART IT.

CTUNIPAR05:

It is set to work with phone buttons, but it is possible to programme it, also for cars which do not have these buttons.

(in this case you will use the audio control buttons)

SOFTWARE PROGRAMMING PROCEDURE

- 1 Open the unit
- 2 Press the key near the wire connector till the red led turns on and stays still
- 3 Release the key
- 4 Press and release the key several times till you reach the number of flashings needed.

5 - Confirm the software programming procedure by pressing the key till the red led turns on again and stays still, now release the key, disconnect and reconnect the 16-pins connector of CTUNIPAROS.

THE PROGRAMMING PROCEDURE SHOULD BE DONE WITH THE UNIT POWERED

WARNING:

Please, follow the above explained procedure only if your car doesn't have any phone button, or for all those cars which are not mentioned on this user guide.

ALTERNATIVELY:

Some car models may have either 1 or 2 phone buttons , for ex. some Volkswagen models have 2 phone buttons instead of 1, with these cars

CTUNIPAR05 is set to work by default with one phone button; in this case please change the unit setting as above described.

CABLES CONNECTIONS



RED = + 12 V (IN) BATTERY

BLACK = GROUND (GND)

ORANGE = service + 15 CAN BUS (OUT) Connect to ORANGE car kit

4 YELLOW/BLACK = MUTE IN connect to Parrot mute cable (YELLOW)

5 YELLOW = MUTE OUT connect to radio mute cable

6 PINK = CAN BUS H line

7 GREEN = CAN BUS L line

8 VIOLET = K-BUS line only for BMW e39 e 46
