<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Using a plastic pry tool remove the bezel from around the DVD player to expose DVD/Radio tuner.</li> <li>2. Lay down a cloth or a towel on center console as to not scratch console when radio is removed.</li> <li>3. Remove (4) Phillips head screws from all (4) corners and (2) 10mm nuts from both sides.</li> <li>4. While holding down the brake pedal. Shift vehicle into Drive to remove radio. Pull radio straight out.</li> <li>5. Remove factory wire harness from behind radio.</li> <li>6. Remove factory fiber optic line from factory harness connector.</li> <li>7. Insert fiber optic line into T-harness. (Radio side).</li> <li>8. Plug T-harness into radio, the other end of the T-harness into factory harness connector.</li> <li>9. Plug in the interface module and mount behind radio/dash.</li> <li>10. Reinstall in reverse order.</li> </ol>	  <p>Remove (4) Phillips head screws</p> <p>Remove (2) 10mm nuts</p>   <p>Factory Fiber Optic cable</p>
