Radio Removal

- 1. Using a plastic pry tool remove dash center trim panel. Images 1 and 2.
- 2. Remove center console trim panels from left and right of center console. Images 3 and 4.
- Remove trim plate behind center console Cup holder tray. Images 5 and 6. Note: make sure the cup holder cover is closed.
- Remove (4) 7mm bolts from around center console cup holder. Images 7 and 8.
- Remove center console cup holder, lift up from the front of cup holder tray and pull towards front of vehicle. Image 8.
- 6. Remove (4) 7mm bolts from around the Lincoln bezel. Image 9.
- While pressing down brake pedal, shift the vehicle into drive. Image 10.
- 8. Pull back on the Shifter Cover, pull out on the top side of the Lincoln bezel and using a plastic pry tool insert and pry up and out on lower corners of the Lincoln bezel to release two retainer clips on bezel. Image 11.
- Once clips are released pull the Lincoln bezel out and then up. Image 12 and 13.
- 10. Remove (4) 7mm bolts from around radio and climate controls, and then pull radio assembly straight out. Images 14 and 15.
- Disconnect factory radio harness and install interface T- harness between radio and factory harness. Plug in interface module and mount in the dash behind radio.
 Reinstall in reverse order.
