- 1 Disconnect the negative batteryterminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Remove ashtray and (1) Phillips head screw inside ashtray cavity. (Figure A)
- 3 Remove knob from climate control slide lever. (Figure B)
- 4 Unsnap and remove radio/climate control trim panel. (Figure C)
- 5 Remove (4) Phillips head screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio.








SEPHIA 1995-1997

*Note: Refer also to the instructions included with the aftermarket radio.

- 1 Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Remove plastic screw cover to the left of the coin tray and remove the Phillips head screw from behind cover.
- 3 Remove switch blank to the far right of the switch panel and remove the Phillips head screw from behind switch blank.
- 4 Unclip and remove dash trim panel.
- 5 Remove (4) Phillips head screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio.






SEPHIA 1998-2001 SPECTRA 2000-2001

- 1 Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Remove (1) Phillips head screw from above instrument cluster.
- 3 Unclip and remove dash trim panel.
- 4 Remove (4) Phillips head screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio.






SPORTAGE 1995-1997

- 4 Remove (4) Phillips head screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio.






5PORTAGE 1998-2000


- 1 Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Unclip and remove climate control/vent trim panel. (Figure A)
- 3 Remove screw covers from trim panel below steering column and remove screws from behind covers. Lower the trim panel (it is not necessary to remove the panel). (Figure B)
- 4 Remove (3) Phillips head screws from bottom of steering column housing and remove both upper and lower sections of housing.
- 5 Remove (1) Phillips head screw from outside left edge of dash and (2) Phillips head screws from near hood release. (Figure C)
- 6 Loosen nut behind hood release and remove lower left side dash trim. (Figure C)
- 7 Remove (4) Phillips head screws from instrument trim panel and remove panel. (Figure D)
- 8 Remove (4) Phillips head screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio.

Continue to kit assembly.














<u>RIO 2001</u> SEPHIA 1995-1997

Cut and remove mounting tabs "B" from Radio Housing #2. (The tabs can be identified by the letter stamped on the back of each tab.) (Figure A)



<u> 5PORTAGE 1995-1997</u>


Cut and remove mounting tabs "A" from Radio Housing #2 and the mounting brackets. (The tabs can be identified by the letter stamped on the back of each tab.) Locate the scored line on the back of the radio housing and break away the bottom portion of the housing as shown. (Figure C)


<u>SEPHIA 1998-2001</u> SPECTRA 2000-2001

Cut and remove mounting tabs "B" from Radio Housing #1. (The tabs can be identified by the letter stamped on the back of each tab.) (Figure B)



5PORTAGE 1998-2003

Cut and remove mounting tabs "A" from Radio Housing #1. Cut and remove tabs "B" from the mounting brackets. (The tabs can be identified by the letter stamped on the back of each tab.) (Figure D)





DIN MOUNT RADIO




NOTE: For Sportage 1995-97 and 1998-03 secure the Mounting Brackets to the Radio Housing with (4) Captive Studs and (4) Pal Nuts. (Figure A)

- Slide the DIN cage into the radio housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs outward. (Figure B)
- 2 Slide the radio into the DIN cage/housing assembly until it snaps into place. (Figure C)





FINAL ASSEMBLY



- (A) Strip wire ends back 1/2"
- B) Twist ends together
- C) Solder
- D) Tape
- 1 Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter and making connections as shown. (Isolate and individually tape off the ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit.)
- **2** Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 3 Reassemble radio and dash assemblies in reverse order of disassembly.

FINAL WIRING CONNECTIONS

Make wiring connections using the EIA color code chart shown below and the instructions included with the head unit. Metra recommends making connections as shown below; Strip, Splice, Solder, Tape. Isolate and individually tape off ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit.

METRA / EIA WIRING CODE

12V Ignition / AccRed	Right Front (+) Gray
12V Batt / Memory Yellow	Right Front (-) Gray/ Black
GroundBlack*	Left Front (+) White
Power AntennaBlue	Left Front (-) White / Black
Amp Turn-On Blue / White	Right Rear (+)Violet
Amp GroundBlack / White	Right Rear (-) Violet / Black
Illumination Orange	Left Rear (+) Green
Dimmer Orange / White	Left Rear (-) Green / Black

^{*}NOTE: When a Black wire is not present, ground radio to vehicle chassis.

All colors may not be present on all leads due to manufacturer's specifications.
