


- **1** Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Remove the ashtray and (1) phillips screw exposed in the ashtray cavity.
- **3** Unclip the dash trim bezel and remove.
- **4** Remove (4) phillips screws from the radio trim bezel.
- **5** Remove (4) phillips screws securing the factory head unit and disconnect the wiring.

### 99-1005 • KIA Spectra

- **1** Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Remove (2) phillips screws from the gage cluster.
- **3** Unsnap and remove the top portion of steering wheel cover.
- **4** Unsnap and remove dash panel.
- **5** Remove (4) phillips screws from radio brackets and remove radio.




Mount the Pocket to the back of the Radio Housing with (2) #8 x 3/8" Phillips Pan Head Screws supplied.




Mount the Rear Support Bracket to the back of the Pocket with (2) #8 x 3/8" Phillips Pan Head Screws supplied.

Slide the DIN cage into the Radio Housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down.

Slide the aftermarket head unit into the cage and secure.

Mount the **Pocket** to the back of the **1** Radio Housing with (2) #8 x 3/8" Phillips Pan Head Screws supplied.



Mount the Rear Support Bracket 2 to the back of the **Pocket** with (2) #8 x 3/8" Phillips Pan Head **Screws** supplied




Align the holes in the ISO Snap In 3 **Brackets** with the holes in the head unit and mount the brackets to the head unit with the screws supplied with the unit.






Snap the ISO Trimplate over the 5 head unit.











1 Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter and making connections as shown. (Isolate and individually tape off the ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit).



## FINAL ASSEMBLY (Continued)

### 99-1005 • KIA Spectra



4 Place the 99-1005 into dash opening; do not bolt in.

- **5** Snap trim bezel back into place and pressure fit kit into place.
- **6** Use aftermarket radio cage to secure installation kit to dash.
- **7** Connect the harness to the aftermarket head unit.
- 8 Install radio into cage.
- 9 Reassemble dash in the reverse order of page 1 in the Dash Disassembly beginning with step #3.
