





Dash Disassembly

- Unclip the right side of the driver's knee bolster panel next to the center console and let hang. Note: There is no need to completely remove the panel. (Figure A)
- 2. Unclip and remove the (2) silver side trim panels from each side of the factory radio. (Figure B)
- **3.** Unclip and remove trim panel below the a/c control panel.

- Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the factory radio, a/c control and a/c vents. (Figure C)
- **5.** Remove the a/c controls. (Figure D)
- **6.** Remove the a/c vent panel. (Figure E)
- **7.** Remove the factory radio. (Figure F)
- 8. If equipped there may be an a/c amp present attached under the radio remove (2) Phillips screws securing the a/c amp.




Kit Assembly

ISO DIN radio provisions with pocket

- If equipped attach the a/c amp to the radio brackets with the factory hardware. (Figure A)
- Mount the pocket to the radio brackets with the (4) #8 X 3/8" Phillips pan head screws supplied. (Figure A)
- 3. Slide the head unit into radio brackets and secure with screws supplied with the unit. (Figure B)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash.
 Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXXESS.
- **5.** Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.
